Cell Phone Policy

Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to ensure a conducive learning environment in our school by minimizing distractions and disruptions caused using cell phones.

Policy Statement

- 1. **Cell phone usage**: Students are required to keep their cell phones switched off and stored away in their bags during school hours. This includes during class time, breaks, and any other school-related activities unless otherwise stated.
